	Folder – contains a selection of documents, including word, powerpoint PDF, and other content, that are listed as separate files. Students may be allowed to download a folder.
	File – a document, powerpoint or other content that will open in an application on desktop, typically MS Office (Word, Excel, PowerPoint, etc.)
	URL – a website external to Moodle accessed by a hyperlink and in some cases embedded onto the Moodle page, such as a YouTube video
	PDF URL – a URL link to a PDF, this will automatically open a PDF file in a new browser window, which can then be downloaded
	Page – instructor-created content that includes text, images, video and activities that is contained within the Moodle learning platform
	Book – collection of pages related to one topic that can be navigated through its chapters and subchapters
ື່ມ	Lesson – an activity module that includes practice questions as checkpoints that may be graded or unlock more activities within the lesson
ĨI	Text and Media Area - *does not appear as an icon on course homepage* - this inserts text and media content (i.e. images) directly into the body of the homepage.

Q	Chat – text-based, real-time discussion open for a determined period of time, such as during a Teams meeting or lecture that creates a log of the discussion
۲°	Choice – a single question posed to enrolled students, typically used for student user agreement forms, where each response is recorded with student's username
:0	Questionnaire – a series of questions to be filled out online, most often an instructor evaluation that will appear at the top of the course page near the end of term



Feedback – a customizable survey with various question-types, anonymous if desired, to collect feedback from students

Open Forum – discussion threads similar to the one below that are not confined to participants enrolled in one course

Collaboration (Orange icons)

Forum – discussion threads designed for a specific topic in a course, unlike Open Forum, limited to groups or all students enrolled in a course



Glossary – collection of terms and phrases related to a course that are created and shared by students, can include images in the definition



Database – large collection of student-generated data that can be commented upon and rated for accuracy by student peers [Database activity - MoodleDocs]



Wiki – enables students to collaboratively, or individually, create and edit a collection of web pages. [Wiki activity - MoodleDocs]

Assessment (Pink icons)



Assignment – a dropbox for documents and other media that needs to be submitted at a certain time and date



Quiz – the most common way to assess student from a short module quiz to final exam, timed to open a close at an exact hour



Workshop – a multistage project that encourages collaboration and even peer assessment as part of the assigned grade



Attendance – records attendance for selected course sessions, can be self-recorded by students, auto-recorded by activity completion, or manually recorded by instructors
